- 1 PM to 5:30 PM You can admire all the **classic cars on the square. Vintage automobiles** from different decades will be parked all around the Lampasas County Courthouse in Downtown Lampasas. Don't miss this chance to relive the bygone days yesteryear! **Kids can ride the "Little Texas Kids Train" for FREE!**
- 1 PM to 7 PM The Town and Country Club will hold their annual **Christmas Bazaar** inside the Courthouse where visitors will find all sorts of **unique holiday gifts and food for sale, most of which are hand-made!** This is inside the Lampasas County Courthouse at the Courtyard Square in Downtown Lampasas, so don't miss this chance for real gifts hand-made by real people. A \$1.00 admission supports scholarships.
- 1 PM to 9 PM  The **Keystone Square Museum** on Western between Second and Third streets has a **Christmas Tree contest, a Gingerbread House contest, and decorations for the occasion.** The theme this year is "Candy Cane Lane". The museum will also have a bake sale going on. Proceeds from the bake sale support programming and exhibitions at the museum. Admission to the museum is always free.
- 4 PM to 7 PM  **Kids' activities include making ornaments and listening to stories read by Mrs. Claus at My Girls restaurant and shop** on the corner of Live Oak and Third Street. Ms. Claus will be reading stories from 3 pm to 4 pm! Helpers are the Lampasas Library Advisory Board members! **My Girls is located on the Northwest corner of the Courtyard Square** and Lampasas County Courthouse. Good fun, good food, good people, good Christmas stories, and great ornaments so don't miss out!
- 4 PM to 7 PM **Old Saint Nick himself will be at Windsor Foods** on the Northeast Corner of the Square! Don't miss this chance for the children to **visit with Santa Clause!**
- 6:30 PM  **The Annual Great Lampasas Lighted Christmas Parade kicks off!** There's just not a good excuse to miss this event! Last year's Lighted Christmas Parade was a huge hit! Lighted floats with everything from storybook themes to a Nativity scene paraded through the town to the square, with Santa and Mrs. Claus bringing up the rear, just before they head back to the North Pole to get ready for Christmas. Last year we saw everything from lawnmowers to bands, to huge semi-trailers to horse and buggies, all lit up in their Christmas finest! The Christmas Parade lights up at Chestnut and 3rd Streets (east of Key Ave and west of Downtown) and the Christmas Parade continues to Hackberry and 3rd Streets (east of Downtown). This year's parade theme is "Candy Cane Lane", presented by Vision
